NOTICE OF RACE

1. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The SB20 Asian Grand Slam and Asia Pacific Championships will be organised by the Singapore Sailing Federation with the support of ONE°15 Marina Sentosa Cove, Singapore for and on behalf of the SB20 Class Association.

2. RULES

2.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2.2 No national prescriptions will apply.

2.3 The SB20 class rules shall apply except that SB20 Class Rule C.5.1 (Mandatory Equipment) is modified and only include C.5.1 (5) A floating throwing line, minimum of 20m long and 6mm in diameter shall be attached at the stern. With this change, these are herein referred to as the Class Rules.

Explanation: This change is to promote participation from the local SB20 fleet by reducing entry barriers and it reflects equipment carried for the local SB20 fleet's racing activities. The OA has the necessary race support, safety and first aid coverage in place during the regatta for safety purposes.

2.4 Should there be any conflict between this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall take precedence.

2.5 If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.

3. ADVERTISING

3.1 Competitor advertising will be restricted to World Sailing Regulation 20.

3.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

4.1 The SB20 Asian Grand Slam and Asia Pacific Championships is open to SB20s that comply with the Class Rules.

4.2 All boats entered must be currently registered with the SB20 Class Association.

4.3 The Organising Authority reserves the right to refuse an entry from any SB20 considered unsuitable for the event.

4.4 The Entry Form is in Attachment 3.

5. ENTRY FEES

- 5.1 A non-refundable entry fee of;
- i. SGD\$600 per team or;
 - ii. SGD\$500 per team where one of the participants has a valid student ID, inclusive of GST, shall be paid in full by participants either by cash, credit card, cheque or bank transfer with the submission of the official entry form to the Regatta Secretariat by **1800H SG time on 18 January 2018**. The Organising Authority may at its discretion accept late entries at a late entry fee of SGD700.
- 5.2 The entry fee includes one(1) T-shirt and one(1) ticket to the closing party per team member, and complimentary berthing for the participating boats, which will be offered at ONE°15 Marina from Saturday, 27 January 2017 to Sunday, 10 February 2017.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available by 19 January 2018 at ONE°15 Marina and at <http://www.sb20asiangrandslam.com>. Full course details will be made available with the Sailing Instructions.

8. MEASUREMENTS

- 8.1 All boats and equipment shall be available for random measurement checks by the Organising Authority.
- 8.2 Crew weighing will be carried out during registration or under exceptional circumstances, and with prior written approval from the Organising Authority, between 0900hrs and 1000hrs on Friday, 2 February 2018.
- 8.3 Sail checks may be carried out during registration.

9. VENUE

9.1 The SB20 Asian Grand Slam and Asia Pacific Championships is hosted by ONE°15 Marina.

9.2 Attachment 1 shows the location of the ONE°15 Marina.

9.3 Attachment 2 shows the location of the racing area.

10. SCORING

10.1 The low point scoring system, provided in Appendix A of World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing, will apply.

10.2 9 races are scheduled for the Regatta.

10.3 A minimum of 4 races are required to constitute the SB20 Asian Grand Slam and Asia Pacific Championships.

10.4 When 6 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

10.5 When fewer than 6 races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

11. COURSES

The courses shall be windward/leeward courses which will be described in the Sailing Instructions and explained at the Skipper's Briefing.

12. BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the ONE°15 Marina.

13. PRIZES

13.1 Prizes will be awarded for the overall top 5 places.

13.2 Individual race winners will be awarded trophies on final day prize giving.

13.3 The overall champion will win the SB20 Asia Pacific Championship Challenge Trophy.

14. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

15. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

16. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.

17. CHARTER BOATS

Singapore Sailing Federation has 8 SB20s available for charter at SGD500 on a first come first served basis. In addition to the charter fee, a damage deposit of SGD500 must be paid upon confirmation of charter.

- 17.1 Interested parties are to complete the charter form and submit to Singapore Sailing Federation together with their payment.
